Fit2Excel Classes

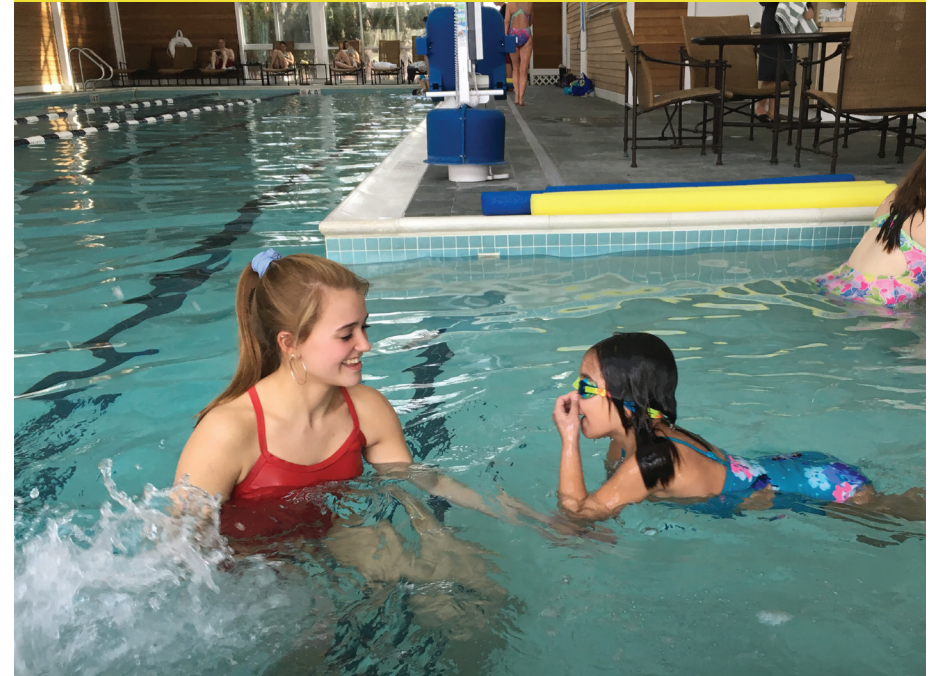
